# SAN DIEGO SHERIFF'S WELLNESS INITIATIVE INTRODUCTION



The San Diego Sheriff's Department has historically worked hard to support sworn law enforcement staff who often times see people on their worst days. These officers and deputies spend their careers taking care of others, and we want to make sure we take care of them, as well.

San Diego County Sheriff, Kelly Martinez, understands the importance of wellness and well-being initiatives for her deputies. She believes that unless deputies and staff are healthy, they cannot take care of the communities we serve.

At the beginning of this year, the Sheriff's Department was granted \$1.8 million from the State of California to fund wellness initiatives. With that money, the Sheriff was able to partially fund a wellness team. Currently, five sworn staff members and three professional staff are working to develop a robust and cohesive strategy to ensure every member of the Sheriff's Department has the resources they need to be strong both physically and mentally.

The Mission Statement of the Wellness Unit is to support the physical, mental, and emotional health of our employees who are fundamental to creating safer communities and a strong workforce. As a team, the unit promotes personal and professional longevity by developing healthy choices to reduce personal risk factors. The Wellness Unit provides training and resources for financial, physical, spiritual, occupational, educational, and emotional wellness for all members of the Sheriff's Department in the effort to obtain overall lifetime wellness.

This is a good start, but more is needed to foster this mission. That includes finding a location for the wellness team to work, counsel, and support the Sheriff's staff. Sheriff Martinez is grateful for the support of the Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association who has answered the call and is in the process of renovating the existing Sheriff's Museum property in Old Town San Diego for this purpose.

Once the Wellness Center becomes a part of the Sheriff's Museum in Old Town, the unit will have an off-site location where department members can meet with unit personnel privately. The meetings can range in scope from just stopping by to say hello, to decompressing in our lounge to seeking new resources, spending time with family, and meeting with our counselor. The Wellness Center will also serve as a central location for critical incident debriefs to be held. Having the Wellness Center in Old Town, away from other Sheriff's locations, provides a safe space for department members seeking assistance. Many of the resources provided are extended to immediate family members including counseling and wellness applications.

We know that healthy deputies and staff will lead to healthier relationships with our communities. The work, dedication, and devotion, of those who serve in the law enforcement profession should be supported and this center will show the commitment of the Sheriff and the Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association in ensuring they are.

Thank you for your consideration of this proposal, and your support of this effort.


